- Previous palliative care experience either in hospital based palliative care, hospice or other healthcare settings with knowledge of the death/dying process.
- Proven ability to work as a member of an interdisciplinary team.
- Enhanced Fundamentals of Palliative Care is an asset (completed or actively pursuing) an asset.
- Resourceful problem-solver with strong communication and interpersonal skills, excellent time management and ability to perform assigned duties with attention to detail.
- Demonstrated commitment to professional continuing education.
- Ability to work 12hr shifts, including day and night shifts.
- Excellent attendance record required.
